2nd STOREY NEWS

After a long time with little movement, things are progressing on this front rather quickly now. With the City of Mandurah engaging Cox Architecture (of Optus Stadium fame) to assist with the design of the second storey addition, the plans have evolved to represent something similar to the artist impression below.

With designs nearly finalised, we will look to go to tender for construction in the coming months with building scheduled to commence in December 2018.

Whilst this will undoubtedly impact on the club during the Nippers/Patrol season, accommodations will be made in the process to enable operations to continue as close to normal as is reasonably possible, though the imposition will be worth it.

Creating a large scale function room with amazing ocean views and additional space for the club should bring with it an improvement in our use of available space and add a bit of flair to the building.

Obviously, the entry foyer (glass like projection below) adds a visual statement and avoids the stairwell and elevator impinging on the internal footprint.

This is an exciting time for the club, so watch this space for updates as the year progresses.
