



# Port Bouvard Surf Lifesaving Club

## Membership Categories 2019/20 Season

Please refer to the following Membership Categories for determining the most appropriate for your membership.

**Please note:** Unless otherwise stated, all Membership fees listed herein apply to Returning Members. Please refer to the Port Bouvard SLSC – Membership Fees document (via the website) to view New Member pricing.

---

### **NIPPERS (Junior Activity Member):**

All children aged from 5 years to 15 years as at the 30th September of each year.

Membership Fee - As per the family membership. (Please refer to fee structure)

**Please note: All new children will need to register as Junior Activity Members. At least ONE ADULT MUST REGISTER WITH A NIPPER.**

---

### **CADETS:**

All members aged from 13 years to 15 years as at the 30th September of each year.

A cadet member needs to be 13 years of age to complete the Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC).

Membership Fee: \$80.00 + training resources: \$40.00 = Total \$120.00

A cadet member needs to be 15 years (by the end of December) to complete the Bronze Medallion (BM)

Membership Fee: \$80.00 + training resources: \$65.00 = Total \$145.00

A cadet member that has already completed the SRC but is not yet eligible to join a Bronze Medallion training group.

Membership Fee: \$80.00

**All cadet SRC members are encouraged to patrol**

---

### **ACTIVE (Junior 15-18):**

All members aged from 15 years to 18 years as at the 30th September of each year whom have already completed their Bronze Medallion.

Membership Fee: \$80.00

All members aged from 15 years to 18 years as at the 30th September of each year whom have not yet completed the Bronze Medallion with no other awards but are training in the Bronze Medallion.

Membership Fee: \$80.00 + training resources: \$65.00 = Total \$145.00

All members aged from 15 years to 18 years as at the 30th September of each year who have not yet completed the Bronze Medallion that hold an SRC and they are updating to the Bronze Medallion.

Membership Fee: \$80.00 + training resources: \$20.00 = Total \$100.00

**All Bronze Medallion holders are required to patrol on our beach.**

---

**ACTIVE (Senior 18+ years and over):**

All members aged 18 years and over as at the 30th September of each year whom have already completed their Bronze Medallion.

Membership Fee: \$100.00

All members aged 18 years and over who hold no award and have not yet completed the Bronze Medallion (Associate Member).

Membership Fee: \$150.00 + training resources: \$65.00 = Total \$215.00

All members aged from 18 years and over as at the 30th September of each year that have not yet completed the Bronze Medallion but have the SRC and are updating to the BM (Award Member)

Membership Fee: \$150.00 plus training resources: \$20.00 = Total \$170.00

**All Bronze Medallion holders are required to patrol on our beach.**

---

**RESERVE ACTIVE (Senior 18+ years and over):**

All members aged 18 years and over as at the 30th September of each year whom have already completed their Bronze Medallion, but do not attend the club regularly and cannot provide time for patrol.

Membership Fee: \$150.00

**AWARD MEMBER:**

All members that have already gained a SRC, Radio award, Resuscitation Certificate, Advanced Resuscitation Certificate, Spinal or a First Aid Certificate.

Membership Fee: \$150.00 plus any fees to complete new or other awards.

**These members may be called upon to patrol on our beach.**

---

**COMMUNITY MEMBER:**

Community/Social members enjoy all the social benefits, are permitted to participate in club social and special events and are bound by the policies of our organisation. Community/Social members have access to member pricing with regard to bar purchases and can bring guests to the club.

Community/Social members are NOT eligible to compete in Surf Life Saving competitions and are not qualified to patrol, nor do they have access to the club showers or the use of any club equipment. Community/Social must be a minimum of 18 years of age.

Community members are eligible to join in community training programmes, open water and ocean swims.

Membership Fee: \$25.00

**ASSOCIATE MEMBER:**

An associate member is one who hold no awards and has no child under the age of 18 years enrolled at Port Bouvard Surf Life Saving Club.

Other membership categories are only available via application and approval from the Executive Committee.

## **OTHER FEES FOR NEW AND COMPETING MEMBERS**

**All nippers are required to wear a skull cap in the colour of their age group.**

Fee: \$12.00

All members that compete in State and National competitions will be required to wear a club competition cap.

Fee: \$12.00

All eligible members that compete in club, State and National competitions will be required to wear a HIVIS Yellow vest.

Fee: \$15.00

All members that choose to compete in any State or National competitions will also need to purchase a club uniform.
